







Pupils make and decorate a name tag. In pairs, or with the teacher, they ask What's your name? and answer I'm (David).








Pupils count the objects and match them to the numbers. The teacher asks *How many?*










Pupils find six differences and circle them in picture 1. They say what the teacher is saying in each picture (Stand up! Sit down! Open your book! or Close your book!).









Pupils colour the pictures. The teacher asks what Magicus is saying in each picture. Pupils answer Stand up! Sit down! Open your book! or Close your book!












Pupils count the candles on each cake and write the numbers. They draw a fourth cake with candles to show their age. The teacher asks *How many?* and *How old are you?*








Pupils trace the lines and match. The teacher says a family member and the pupils say the matching birthday objects, and vice versa.













Pupils look at the party objects and circle the one that is different in each row. The teacher asks What's this? What number? and How many?






A Colour the party things and say.






Pupils draw lines to match the pets to their owners. The teacher asks What's this? Pupils say It's my (mouse).




Pupils complete the drawings by tracing over the faint lines. The teacher asks What's this? Pupils say It's a (fish).

Pupils circle a body part on the creature and draw a line to the animal it matches. The teacher asks What's this? Pupils say It's a (dog).


















Pupils number the story frames and tell the teacher the story of Episode 3 in their first language. They colour the characters.







A Pupils trace over the lines and make a sentence for each person using *l've got a* B Pupils draw lines to match the body parts to the animals. The teacher asks What's this?




















Pupils circle the missing body parts. The teacher says the name of each character and pupils say the missing body part.














The pupils throw a die and do the action. They say the action and tick it off. They continue until they have ticked all six actions.




Colour and say.




Join the dots and say.



Pupils join the dots and complete the pictures. They say the numbers. The teacher asks What's this?











Decorate and colour the Christmas tree.






Pupils draw on decorations, then colour the tree. The teacher asks What's this? and How many presents?
